

# Keely's Most Useful Dishcloth



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## Supplies & Such

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### Supplies

- 100% cotton, worsted weight (95 yds)  
we used Sugar 'n Cream Twists
- Needles, size 7 (4.5mm) and 10 (6mm)
- Crochet Hook, size H

### Gauge

20 sts = 4" in stockinette stitch with smaller needle

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## Abbreviations & Definitions

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### Threaded Stitch

\*Insert tip of right hand needle purlwise through first st, k the second stitch leaving it on the needle and drawing loop back through the first st, knit the the first stitch through the back loop, slip both sts off the needle together; repeat from \*

<b>k</b>	Knit
<b>ch</b>	Chain
<b>sc</b>	Single crochet
<b>dc</b>	Double crochet
<b>st(s)</b>	Stitch(es)
<b>Sl</b>	Slip
<b>WSR</b>	Wrong Side Row



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## Instructions

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With larger needle, cast on 42 sts.

Row 1 - With smaller needle, knit (WSR)

Row 2 - With larger needle, purl

Row 3 - With smaller needle, K1, work Threaded Stitch across row until 1 st remains, K1.

Row 4 - With larger needle, purl

Row 5 - With smaller needle K2, work Threaded Stitch across row until 2 sts remain, K2.

Repeat rows 2-5 until cloth measures 8", ending with row 5.

Bind off with larger needle purlwise - do not fasten off.

Insert crochet hook into last loop. Work sc around each edge, working 3 sc into each corner. Sl st into first sc. Ch 2, \*dc, ch1; repeat from star around cloth, working one (dc, ch1) into each sc and two (dc, ch1) into each corner space. Sl st into first dc and fasten off.

Block to finished size.
