
Mulberry Merino Cowl

Supplies

- Plymouth Mulberry Merino - 2 skeins (198 yards) or comparable worsted weight yarn
- Needles, size 10.5 (6.5mm)

Gauge

14sts = 4" in stockinette stitch

Finished Size

30" circumference x 12"

Instructions

Cast on 105 sts. Join in round.
Knit 5 rounds. Purl 5 rounds.
Continue alternating 5 knit and 5 purl rounds until cowl measures desired width, ending with 5 knit rounds.
Bind off loosely.



Abbreviations

k	Knit
p	Purl
st(s)	Stitch(es)
k2tog	Knit 2 sts together

Chemo Cap

Supplies

- Plymouth Mulberry Merino - 2 skeins (198 yards) or comparable worsted weight yarn
- Needles, size 7 (4.5mm), 16" circular and double point

Gauge

20sts = 4" in stockinette stitch

Instructions

Cast on 88 sts and join in round. Work in stockinette stitch (knit every round) for 5.5".
Begin crown decreases, switching to DPNs when necessary.
Decrease round - *K2, K2tog, repeat from * around (66 sts)
Work 10 rounds without shaping
Decrease round - *K1, K2tog, repeat from * around (44 sts)
Work 3 rounds without shaping
Decrease round - *K2tog, repeat from * around (22 sts)
Work 1 round without shaping

Baby Alpaca Scarf

Supplies

- Plymouth Baby Alpaca DK Paint - 2 skeins (250 yards) or comparable dk weight yarn
- Needles, size 9 (5.5mm)

Gauge

21sts = 4" in alternate rib pattern

Finished Size

5" x 50"

Instructions

Cast On 25 sts. Work in alternate rib as follows:

Row 1

*P1, K3, repeat from * until 1 st remains, P1

Row 2

K2, *P1, K3, repeat from * until 3 sts remain, P1, K2

Repeat rows 1 & 2 until desired length, then Bind Off in pattern. Add fringe.
