

Countdown to Christmas



Supplies & Such

Supplies

- Brew City Yarns - Countdown to Christmas Kit
- Size 10 (6mm) 40" circular knitting needle, or size to get gauge
- Size 10.5 (6.5mm) knitting needle, for bind off

Gauge

20 sts = 4" in linen stitch, before blocking

Finished Size

70" x 12" after blocking

Abbreviations

CO	Cast on
K2tog	Knit 2 stitches together
st(s)	Stitch(es)
Sl1 wyif	Slip one with yarn in front

Instructions

Note: Mindless knitting at its best! Spiraling linen stitch is worked over an odd number of stitches, therefore there is no need to mark beginning of round. Simply K1, Sl1 wyif around and around until the scarf is complete. Just make sure you are maintaining the linen stitch, knitting slipped stitches and slipping the knits.

Scarf is worked with 2 strands held together throughout.

With one strand of **Undyed** and one strand of **A Partridge in a Pear Tree**, CO 345 sts using a provisional cast on. Join in the round.

Work around as follows:

Round 1: *K1, Sl1 wyif; repeat from * until 1 st remains, K1.
Round 2: *Sl1 wyif, K1; repeat from * until 1 st remains, Sl1 wyif.

Work until all of the hand dyed color has been used, and continue with a strand **Two Turtle Doves** held together with the strand of **Undyed**.

Work until all of the hand dyed color has been used, and continue with a strand **Three French Hens** held together with the strand of **Undyed**.

Work until all of the hand dyed color has been used, and continue with a strand **Four Calling Birds** held together with the strand of **Undyed**.

Cut Undyed yarn. Continue working with one strand of **Five Golden Rings** and **Six Geese A-Laying**, until all of these two colors have been used.

Continue working with one strand of **Seven Swans A-Swimming** and **Eight Maids A-Milking**, until all of these two colors have been used.

Continue working with one strand of **Nine Ladies Dancing** and **Ten Lords A-Leaping**, until all of these two colors have been used.

Continue working with one strand of **Eleven Pipers Piping** and **Twelve Drummers Drumming**, until a approximately 20 yards of are left. Knit the last round.

With larger needle bind off as follows: *K2tog, slip stitch back to left needle; repeat around until one stitch remains and fasten off. Block to size.
