

Crocheting for Comfort



Crocheted Cleavage is a set of two crocheted breast prostheses that are very comfortable, light weight, and soft alternatives to typical breast prosthesis. These are for women who have undergone mastectomies or lumpectomies. They can be worn with any regular bra and are machine washable. They are overstuffed with Polyfil to allow for adjustment, and they can be customized by removing or adding Polyfil.

Crocheted Cleavage are being made with love as part of my Girl Scout Gold Award Project and will be distributed for free to survivors of breast cancer through Breast Cancer Survivors of Oklahoma, a non-profit organization.
