

Lattice Lace Scarf

A lightweight yet cozy accessory created with a knotted openwork stitch, perfect for accenting yarns with a beautiful loft and sheen.

👄 yarn

OnLine Linie 450 Landia
1 skein #02/Wine
or 142yds comparable worsted weight yarn

👄 needles & notions

Size 15 (10mm)

👄 gauge

14 stitches & 14 rows = 4" in knotted openwork stitch

👄 finished size

Before Blocking: 6.5" wide and 54" long
After Blocking: 8" wide and 64" long



👄 instructions

Loosely cast on 20 stitches.

Row 1 (RSR): S1, purl to end

Row 2: S1, K2, *YO, K3 - then pass the first stitch over the second and third sts; repeat from * until 2 sts remain, K2

Row 3: S1, purl to end

Row 4: S1, K1, *K3 - then pass the first stitch over the second and third sts, YO; repeat from * until 3 sts remain, K3

These four rows establish the knotted openwork stitch. Repeat rows 1 - 4 until scarf measures 54", then work row 1 once more.

Bind off as follows: *K2tog, move stitch back to left needle; repeat from * until 1 stitch remains, fasten off.

Block to finished size.

Seam short ends together to form a ring, and work in ends.

👄 abbreviations

K	Knit
K2tog	Knit two stitches together
S1	Slip one stitch purlwise
st(s)	Stitch(es)
RSR	Right side row
YO	Yarn over
